¹⁾ Innovation is an activity which provides a good or a service that is “new or significant improved with respect to its characteristics or intended uses or a new or significantly improved process, a new marketing method or a new organizational method in the firm’s business practices, workplace organization or external relations”. Innovation is based on results of new technologies, mix of existing technologies or other knowledge gained by organization. “The minimum requirement for an innovation is that product, process, marketing method or organizational method must be *new* (or significant improved) to the firm.” In this way, “the innovation activities are all scientific, technological, organizational, financial and commercial steps which actually, or are intended to, lead to the implementation of innovations. Some innovation activities are themselves innovative, other are not novel activities but are necessary for the implementation of innovation”.
